Day 3. Today the adventure tour around Iceland starts. Jóhann will pick you up at your hotel around 9 am, you will have time to enjoy your breakfast and get ready.

We will drive out from Reykjavík to Mosfellsbær, there we will take road nr 36 over to Þingvellir. At Þingvellir we will walk down into Almannagjá, the fissure that splits Iceland in two as the tectonic plates EuroAsian and the American plate drift apart. Þingvellir is not only geologically interesting with volcanoes all around, it is also very interesting because of how big a role it has in our history of Iceland. After exploring Þingvellir we will jump back on board in our

bus for our next destination, Geysir.

## Lunch

After lunch we will get back on track and arrive at Geysir within 20 min driving. The hot spring area at Geysir is of course most famous for the old Geysir that used to erupt all the time, up to 60 - 80 meters each time. We even have documents from 1800 that say 170 meters. Now Geysir is old and sleepy but there is another spring that erupts all the time (every 8-10 minutes) but not as big, this one is named Strokkur and is now the main attraction in the Geysir geothermal area.

From Geysir we drive to our next destination, Gullfoss waterfall. It will only take us 15 min driving to Gullfoss, and again we will walk around and drink in the beauty and the history.

After Gullfoss we head on to our hotel for the night,

Day 4. After breakfast at Hotel Gullfoss, we jump on board our bus. Today we are heading inland to visit the amazing area of Kerlingarfjöll.

The drive up there will take us around 2 hours, we will ask the staff at Gullfoss to prepare take away lunch for us so we can go directly up to the mountains to explore the wonders of [Kerlingarfjöll](#).

I would love to guide the group up on top of Snækollur but we just have to see how fit the group members will be and of course weather conditions.

After a challenging day in the mountains it will be so rewarding to go to the nature baths at the hotel and enjoy the dinner buffet they are usually offering.

Stay overnight in the Highland Center

Day 5. Today we will leave the mountains and drive back towards Gullfoss. We will keep on going to the south coast of Iceland.

This might be a good day to go to Réttir (Tungnaréttir and Reykjaréttir will most likely be Saturday **September 12th. 2026** and they are on our way to the south) After watching the farmers rounding up the sheep we will keep our journey going, we will next aim for visiting Seljalandsfoss, but we will stop for lunch either at Selfoss or Hvolsvöllur. At Seljalandsfoss we will spend little time, walk behind the waterfall and even visit the neighbor Gljúfrabúi but then I would like to take the group away from the main tourist area and visit a spot that fewer people know about but is an adventure to visit, it is called Nauthúsagil.

After Nauthúsagil we keep on going east, we will take a quick stop at Skógafoss before heading to our hotel in the area of Vík.

Stay overnight in the Vík area.

Day 6. Today we will start by exploring the nature pearls close to Vík.

Dyrhólaey, the southernmost part of Iceland and Reynisfjara is a must visit, If the group is interested then I can take a quick visit to may families farm, we can go to the Lava Show in Vík and if they are interested in doing some hiking then I recommend either hiking up to Reynisfjall (one of the best viewing spots in the area on a clear day) or we can visit the grave of the Viking Hjörleifur on top of Hjörleifshöfði, I can even take them up my secret Viking path and of course we will visit YodaCave before heading further east towards Jökulsárlón.



Stay overnight at near Glacier Lagoon

Day 7. Today we will explore the area of Jökulsárlón. The last few days have been packed so today I suggest a little bit more relaxed.

I suggest we book a Zodiac tour around 10am. After the tour we have few options, they can book a glacier walk at from Jökulsárlón or we can drive back to Skaftafell and hike up to Svartifoss waterfall, I can take them to amazing viewing point over Skaftafellsjökull glacier tongue and up to Öräfajökull and some of Iceland's highest mountains located in Öräfajökull volcano.

Stay overnight at a hotel in the Glacier Lagoon area.

Day 8. Today we will switch over to the east coast of Iceland. We will aim for Egilsstaðir, (250 km).

We will just drive and enjoy the view both outside the window and of course we will stop on good viewing spots. I suggest stopping for Lunch at Djúpvogur (174km from Jökulsárlón).

We can stop at [Steinasafn Petru](#) (stone collection) at Stöðvarfjörður . It is amazing. We must keep our eyes open while we drive because in this area we will have the best chance to see wild Reindeer.

I would like to take the group to see the Reindeers in the [Reindeer park](#), in Fellabær next to Egilsstaðir, they close at 5:00 pm so it would be good to be there no later than 4:00 pm.

Stay overnight at Lake Hotel Egilsstaðir

Day 9. Today we will drive from Egilsstaðir to Lake Mývatn. We will stop at the hot spring area at Námaskarð, we will explore the area with bubbling mud pools and steamy craters and other strange phenomenon.

From Námaskarð is a short ride to the Nature Baths at Mývatn, we can stop there for a relaxing bath before exploring little more around Mývatn, perhaps hiking on Hverfjall or exploring the beauty of Dimmuborgir.

Stay overnight at in Myvatn area

Day 10. Today we will drive to Akureyri, the capital of the north of Iceland. The drive is only 76 km so it will only take us a little over 1 hour to get there, we will of course stop at Goðafoss (yes you are right one more amazing waterfall) The plan today is to do a whale watching tour from Akureyri. We can book at 9:00 am or 1:00 pm tour (we can make it for the 9:00 tour if we leave at 7:00 am. (fine by me))

The tour is around 2 - 3 hours so if we make it for the 9:00 tour we can have lunch after the tour and then we can go to the Forest baths (Skógarböðin) around 2:00 pm

Stay overnight at Akureyri

Day 11. Today we will drive all the way to Snæfellsnes.

We have a long drive from Akureyri to Búðir, this day will mostly be driving but of course we have a lot to see on the go.

We will be staying at Snæfellsness for two nights.

Day 12. Today we will explore the wonders of Snæfellsnes. We will make a round trip on the peninsula, first we drive over to the north side, we will drive through beautiful landscape, mountains and lava fields and the biggest fjord in Iceland Breiðafjörður that lies between Snæfellsnes and the Westfjords (Vestfirðir)

Shortly we will reach the first town, Grundarfjörður, there we have the iconic mountain Kirkjufell and of course one more waterfall named [Kirkjufellsfoss](#).

(I have heard nice words about the [Kayaking tours from Grundarfjörður](#) if you want to look into that.)

From Kirkjubefelli we drive further out on the peninsula to the town of Ólafsvík. We keep on going all the way to the tip of the peninsula and then we will start heading east again on the south side of the peninsula.

We have few places to stop on the way to explore, we will do short hike if weather is good, I always like to take people to the cave, Vatnshellir, this cave is easy but still you need to be sure footed because it is not fun to fall in your hands and knees in the sharp lava rock.

We will end this day at Hotel Búðir again after exploring a big part of Snæfellsnes. If people like to do some hiking in the area (if we have time) then the hike to Búðaklettur or just down to the cliffs at the sea get you extra energy. People in Iceland believe there is some hidden power in the surrounding area of Snæfellsjökull glacier, perhaps you will feel it too.

Day 13. Today we will finish the round trip in Iceland, this is the last day with Johann.

After breakfast we will start our last day together, we drive east on the peninsula until we will reach the main road again at Borgarnes, we might stop there for a refreshment but then we keep on going.

We drive through the longest tunnel in Iceland under Hvalfjörð (Whale Fjord) and shortly after we close the circle when we drive into the city area in Reykjavík again.

And we keep on going through the city and out on Reykjanes Peninsula to the area of the amazing BlueLagoon. It is good to be here early so you will have more time to enjoy the BlueLagoon
